INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF POMEROY AND GARFIELD COUNTY FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT NO. 1 FOR FIRE AND AMBULANCE SERVICES

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Pomeroy, Washington passed an Ordinance calling for a vote on whether the City should join and become a part of Garfield County Fire Protection District No. 1 ("District") through annexation; and

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WHEREAS, through passage of a Resolution, the District Commissioners concurred with the action of the City Council and requested that the matter of annexation be placed before the voters within the District and City; and

WHEREAS, on November 3, 2009, an election was held and the majority of voters supported annexation of the City to the District; and

WHEREAS, the City and District presently are parties to that certain Contract for Ambulance Service dated January 10, 1973 ("Contract for Ambulance Service") and that Mutual Aid Agreement dated May 10, 1995 ("Mutual Aid Agreement"); and

WHEREAS, the District and City intend to replace both the Contract for Ambulance Service and Mutual Aid Agreement with this Agreement, which the District Commissioners and the City Council have determined to be in the best interests of the citizens of the City and District, now, there, the City and District agree as follows:

Section 1: The recitals set forth above herein are made a part of this Agreement.

Section 2: The term of this Agreement shall be from January 1, 2010 to December 31, 2010, unless terminated earlier by mutual agreement of the parties.

Section 3: The Contract for Ambulance Service is hereby mutually terminated effective December 31, 2009. Ambulance services provided by the District to the City shall continue to be provided by the District in the same manner as the District now provides the same to its own non-City areas of the District.

Section 4: The Mutual Aid Agreement between the City and District is terminated effective December 31, 2009. The City and District recognize that the District will not receive tax revenues from the City annexation until the taxes are imposed against the City taxpayers, both of which will begin effective January 1, 2011. For this reason, the City agrees to compensate the District for providing fire protection services to the City in the same manner as the District provides fire protection services to non-City areas of the District during the year of 2010 in exchange for the transfer of City-owned equipment as detailed on Exhibit A and all interest in the Fire Station and all real property.

Section 5: The District and City recognize that effective at midnight on December 31, 2009, the City shall no longer have a fire chief, a volunteer fire department, or any other active participation in fire suppression efforts, which efforts shall all be performed and services provided by the District beginning at that time.

Section 6: The terms of this Agreement shall be administered by the Mayor on behalf of the City and by the Chairperson of the Fire District Board of Commissioners on behalf of the District.

Section 7: No new entity is intended to be created by the terms of this Agreement.

Section 8: All services to be provided, pursuant to this Agreement, shall be performed by employees of the District or volunteers of the District. Under no circumstances shall any individuals providing fire suppression or ambulance services for the District be considered or treated as employees or volunteers of the City.

Section 9: This Agreement shall be effective upon the passage and approval by both the City Council and District Board of Commissioners and shall be recorded with the Garfield County Auditor.
